



HAZMAT COMPLIANCE NOTICE, 12.09.05 Rev 2

CLOSURE The outer carton and inner package components you receive from LPS Industries, are part of a tested and certified UN performance oriented combination pack. To be in compliance, all proper components **MUST** be used and assembled correctly.

Complete closure instructions are printed on the outer carton.

Copies of the closure instructions for any of our packs can be printed from the LPS website at www.lpsind.com/HazMat.htm (Choose a pack from the list)

PRIMARY CONTAINERS All LPS Industries UN4G combination packs are designed, tested and certified to be used with specific primary containers. A variation in the specification of a primary container could cause your shipment to be out of compliance.

Note: Our UN4GV Exemption Package (DOT-SP 8249) **DOES** allow a variation in primary containers. See **49 CFR 178.601(g)(1)(i)** Contact us with any questions regarding the specifications of the primary containers for our stock packs.

DOT-SP 8249 Exempt Pack (Formally DOT-E 8249) The Exemption document, explaining the proper use of the Exempt Package, **MUST** be retained at each location the Exempt Pack is used. See **49 CFR 173.22a(b)** A copy is sent with all Exempt Packs.

For Liquids, the Exempt Pack requires use of cellulose wadding. (Sold separately)

AIR SHIPMENTS To ship via AIR, the shipper has additional requirements for marking and labeling, cushioning and absorption, and containment of inner packages.

See **49 CFR 173.27(c)**, **IATA 7.1.5.8 and 5.0.2.12**

Liquids sent via AIR **MUST** be contained in a vessel, which meets a minimum hydrostatic pressure test. See **49 CFR 173.27(c)(2) and IATA 5.0.2.9**

Note: UPS shipments must meet Passenger Plane requirements.

THE SHIPPER IS RESPONSIBLE to determine suitability of packaging with material being shipped. Please consult all appropriate DOT, UN, ICAO and IATA regulations.
